- Collections averaged 7508 per month *except Dec which is always quieter*
- Collections have consistently been reducing since Mar 24 *average 6571*
- Overall we are collecting nearly 1000 items less each month this year.

Care Home's – A quick win!



- In accordance with the Somerset Care Home Policy, equipment provided into a Care Home settings is prescribed for individual patients only and SHOULD NOT BE SHARED
- Equipment provided is to suit the need of individuals
- Equipment can be easily returned, all equipment has a label, which has clear instructions of who to contact
- We can also provide posters for staff, to ensure the safe return/collection of equipment

What Can we do?

- Equipment Provision Loaned or Purchased
 - Wholesale Prices
 - Bulk Purchase discount
 - Self funding options
 - Telecare (& install)
- Maintenance and Repair
 - LOLER
 - PAT
 - Repair Service
- Decontamination
- Transfer of Equipment
 - Care Home Home
- Minor Adaptations
- Trusted Assessor
- Ferrule Checks
- Training









- Medequip can complete up to 2 audits a month,
- We will closely monitor any increase in scrap as a result of equipment that is returned in poor condition.
- A Medequip member of staff will attend with someone from Somerset to support the audit. A large, wheeled container has been purchased to assist in the collection with our Return Recycle Reuse details on the side.
- Report detailing all items collected and status of each item. This will be sent to Somerset within 8 working days.



Medequip internal process

- Somerset will have a list of items on site which is compiled using the 'All items onsite' report from TCES. Service users' equipment needs to be scanned to check that it is with the correct client.
- Any items that were ordered for a client now deceased or no longer at that address should be returned to the depot and items that are not with the correct client are removed or returned to the original user.
- Any equipment that is assessed as no longer needed or being used inappropriately should also be returned.

Once back at the depot

- All items that come off the van that have been collected should be added to an excel document.
- The backdoor process needs to be followed to ensure the equipment is removed from client site/file
- After the cleaning cycle time has elapsed each EIN needs to be checked on Medequip One. The spreadsheet then needs to be updated appropriately with the current status of the item i.e. shelf, scrap.
- The report can then be sent on to the contract within 8 working days.





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
